How can we shape educational work and civic engagement in ways that do not reproduce colonial patterns of thought? Which methods support a decolonial practice - and what does this mean concretely for our engagement in projects, initiatives, and partnerships?

Within this seminar, we warmly invite students, volunteers, educators, and multipliers to sharpen perspectives together and explore new approaches. Participation is open to everyone interested in learning more about global justice and colonial continuities.

The Adivasi-Tea-Project (ATP) has been working in partnership with Adivasis (Indigenous communities) in the Nilgiri Hills of South India for 30 years, promoting education for sustainable development. Göttingen Postkolonial is an open network in the Göttingen region that addresses the legacies of colonial history, postcolonial present realities, and visions of a decolonial future.

- Lecture on colonial continuities in India with a special focus on the situation of Indigenous peoples (Saturday, 4–7 pm)
